# Eligibility

- Youth 24 and younger who reside in LA County
- Targeted Communities (priority but not required):
  - Current/former foster youth and other system-impacted youth
  - BIPOC TGI+ Youth
  - TAY (16 - 24)

# Inventory

The Rainbow Boutique can provide a variety of items and services that help youth authentically express yourself. These include clothing, shapewear, accessories, and services.

The inventory at the Boutique varies and typically includes binders, wigs, gaffs/tucking underwear, makeup, skincare, and accessories.

All other items such as clothing, shoes, etc. are custom ordered to meet the needs of the youth requesting them.

If you're looking for specific items, let us know when you schedule your visit.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## How can I visit?

The Boutique is located in Hollywood near the LGBT Youth Center, with pop-ups happening throughout the county.. Book an advanced appointment by visiting [calendly.com/rainbowboutique](https://calendly.com/rainbowboutique)

## How long is a visit?

The visit lasts as long as you need it to. We recommend planning for 30 minutes to an hour.

## Do I have to come in person?

Youth are welcome to join us at the Boutique in Hollywood or at a pop-up throughout LA. If you can't make it in person, we can arrange for items to be ordered and delivered to you.

## How do I get to the Boutique?

Once we've confirmed your visit, please let us know if you need transportation assistance. We are located off of several Metro bus routes. We can also help you get to/from the Boutique.

## How often can I visit?

There is no limit on how frequently a youth can visit/utilize the Boutique. Each youth's needs are different.

## Is there a limit on what I can get?

Each youth's needs are considered on a case-by-case basis. While we may not be able to purchase expensive items such as designer shoes, we can make sure youth have what they need.

## Do you provide any services?

Youth wishing to access gender-affirming services such as haircuts can be connected through the Boutique. As the world's largest LGBTQ+ organization, we can also connect youth to other programs and services such as healthcare, legal services, housing supports, and more.
